The 2026 PCC nominations and subsequent elections will take place via electronic means. **Nominations are now open for the** below noted positions on the PCC Board of Directors. Please note that you must be a Tier 1 member in good standing to occupy a Board seat. Nominations will remain open until **Wednesday May 6th at 3:00 p.m. EST**. - Newfoundland – three-year term
- New Brunswick – three-year term
- Alberta – three-year term
- Yukon – two-year term
- Central regional seat (Ontario and Quebec) - three-year term
- Western regional seat (B.C. & Territories) - three-year term

Upon the close of nominations, you will receive an email stating the names of all the individuals nominated. In the event only one individual is nominated for a Board seat, they will be acclaimed. If more than one individual is nominated, an election will be required, and we will send a subsequent email with instructions on how to cast your vote. All nominated individuals are encouraged to prepare a candidacy statement in the event of an election.

Once the PCC Board of Directors has been confirmed we will conduct a call for nominations for the Executive roles of **President** and **Vice President**.
